WELCOME BACK, SOLDIERS, AIRMEN, FAMILY, AND FRIENDS, TO THE WOLVERINE GUARD.

In our second issue since revitalizing this publication, we take the opportunity to update you on news, events, and other happenings around the Michigan military community. There is much to celebrate! Our tempo continues to be extremely rapid – yet intentional – as we pursue the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs' goal to synchronize strategic, legislative, and fiscal initiatives to build and sustain military readiness, care, and advocate for veterans, and cultivate purposeful partnerships. I am pleased to report we are making progress on these objectives every day.

A critical element of our success comes from those key partnerships and advocates outside our organization. More than any other time in its history, the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs and the Michigan National Guard are blessed with overwhelming support from our elected leadership at the state and federal levels. Their remarkable advocacy is a testament to the trust our department has earned through your tireless investment of talent, passion, and tenacity.

Over the past several months, we have seen tangible results of this support. In May, Gov. Whitmer signed legislation that enhances the Michigan National Guard Student Tuition Assistance Program (MINGSTAP). These changes allow our service members to transfer unused tuition assistance benefits to their spouses and children – a vital acknowledgment that our strength comes from our Soldiers and Airmen and the families who support them.

We are also making great strides toward modernizing our facilities to provide a more equitable environment for women in our ranks. For this purpose, Gov. Whitmer has pledged \$55 million in state funding while U.S. Sen. Gary Peters has secured \$26 million in federal monies. We are extremely grateful for this support, and this summer we will be celebrating these improvements at groundbreaking ceremonies across the state.

To continue to build our readiness and stay at the forefront of modernization, a massive effort is underway to recapitalize the A-10 fighter mission at Selfridge Air National Guard Base. Once again, incredibly robust support from our elected officials is key as we pursue a future fighter mission such as the F-35, F-15EXF, or the Next Generation Air Dominance platform. We are certain Selfridge is – and will remain – one of Michigan's greatest assets for our national security.

As you know, freedom is not free. It is an investment we must continually make, and the price is not always monetary. That is why we are responsible for providing the highest possible quality of training and resources for service members who depend on Michigan's training areas to maintain readiness for the duties our nation requires. This year, Northern Strike 23-2 hosted more than 7,000 service members from across all branches and components and multiple partner nations including Latvia. This year marks the 30th anniversary of the State Partnership Program; in that time, our cooperation with Latvia has grown into a close friendship. Events like what we are seeing in Ukraine further underscore the necessity of the SPP and the strength and security it brings. We can be proud that Latvia and Michigan were the first pairings in the SPP, which has now grown to over 85 similar partnerships.

These are just a few key events and milestones this organization can celebrate as we look ahead to a very busy summer. With a successful Training year already completed this summer, I invite you to join me for a moment to reflect, appreciate all we can be thankful for, and consider thanking your own support network for what they do to make your personal mission successful. Remember that relationships, key supporters, and partners are the foundation for everything we accomplish. We cannot do what we do alone.

# MI VETERANS LEADERSHIP SUMMIT

More than 200 military veteran leaders and advocates from 90 cities, five states, and Washington, D.C., came together May 3–5 to develop new and better ways to serve Michigan veterans and their families.

The second annual Michigan Veterans Leadership Summit was planned and developed by veteran stakeholders across Michigan and facilitated by the Michigan Veterans Affairs Agency (MVAA), the central coordinating point for the state's 530,000plus veterans.

With 215 attendees, the event, held at the VFW Cherryland Post 2780 in Traverse City, was nearly twice as large as last year's inaugural event in East Lansing.

"This was a true grassroots effort that brought together veteran advocates from across the state to create better coordination of services and to fill gaps in services," said MVAA Deputy Director Robert Near. "From the county-level Veterans Affairs offices to the Veteran Service Organizations to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, we thank our many partners for their commitment to improving the support and care we offer our veterans."

The keynote address was given by Jim McCloughan, a South Haven resident and Army veteran who was awarded the Medal of Honor for his heroic efforts as a combat medic in Vietnam. McCloughan said one of the biggest lessons he learned as a newly drafted private was to trust his war-tested noncommissioned officers.

"I may have had a bachelor's degree at the time, but they had master's degrees as warriors and I was a kindergartener in that regard," McCloughan said. "I was smart enough to know how dumb I was. I listened to everything, and I did become a pretty good warrior." Read McCloughan's full story at <u>michigan.gov/MVAA</u>.

The summit provided new information for veterans. Gary Easterling, lead agent for the Michigan Veterans Coalition (MVC), noted that the coalition has a new website, <u>www.miveteranbenefits.org</u>, and a new phone number, 1-833-648-3826. Veterans can contact the coalition to access one of its 75 Veteran Service Officers (VSO) throughout the state. The MVC consists of the American Legion, VFW, Disabled American Veterans, and Vietnam Veterans of America, and its services are free to veterans. Veterans seeking a VSO can also go through their county-level Veterans Affairs office. Garth Wooten works with Oakland County Veterans Services and belongs to the Michigan Association of County Veterans Counselors (MACVC). The MACVC, which has 159 members serving 77 counties, assists veterans and their dependents in obtaining any and all federal, state, and local benefits to which they are entitled. Eric Deters, chief strategy officer of the VA Ann Arbor Healthcare System, said the VA has opened three new CBOCs in the past 18 months (in Canton, Adrian and Howell) and is in the process of opening several more around Michigan to improve access.

Getting veterans to sign up for VA health care can be difficult. An estimated 225,000 Michigan veterans did not receive VA health care services last year. Deters said some veterans believe by signing up for VA health care, they're taking that spot away from another veteran who may need the care more. But the Legislature sets the budget for VA health care based on how many people sign up, meaning if a veteran signs up but doesn't use the health care, he or she is essentially leaving that money on the table for another veteran.

#### "The best thing you can do for other veterans is to enroll in VA health care," Deters said.

The summit included a panel on how to better support underserved veterans, including women veterans, incarcerated veterans, and homeless veterans. Erika Hoover, MVAA's women veterans and special populations coordinator, said the official estimate of homeless veterans in Michigan is 2,300. However, that number is likely much higher due to issues such as veterans not meeting the federal definition of homeless and homeless women veterans refusing to identify as veterans and seeking needed services for fear of losing their children.

Hoover also noted that June 12 is Women Veterans Recognition Day — and the 75th anniversary of women being allowed to serve in the military. She said this is not a separate Veterans Day for women, but instead, a day to recognize that women have not always been allowed to serve openly in the military.

This year's Women Veterans Conference was held Oct. 19-22 at the UAW Black Lake Conference Center in Onaway.



# MVAA CELEBRATES 10 YEARS

The Michigan Veterans Affairs Agency (MVAA) is celebrating 10 years of serving veteran families and working alongside its partner organizations to connect Michigan's former service members to their earned benefits in health care, education, employment, and other quality-of-life areas.

The MVAA started operations on March 20, 2013, two months after being signed into existence by executive order as the central coordinating agency for the state's 550,000plus veterans, Michigan National Guard members, and Reservists.



In the decade since the MVAA has handled more than 150,000 cases for veterans through its 1-800-MICH-VET call center, distributed millions of dollars in emergency aid, and connected countless veterans to benefits through the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and other organizations. Gov. Gretchen Whitmer and the state Legislature have shown their commitment to Michigan's veteran families by removing barriers to professional success, creating veteran-friendly initiatives, and investing heavily in veteran suicide prevention efforts.

"More than a half million men and women in Michigan have served in the armed forces selflessly and deserve unfettered access to quality education and training opportunities, good-paying jobs, and affordable health care and mental health services," Whitmer said. "The Michigan Veterans Affairs Agency has a decade of experience in connecting our veterans to these benefits and resources. With my administration's full backing, the agency will continue providing this critical support and expand efforts to reach and serve more veteran families in Michigan."

MVAA Director Adam Hollier said the agency is aggressively addressing the factors that can lead to veteran suicide, as well as supporting veteran spouses and dependents and partnering with other veteran-centric organizations to broaden services. "When we talk about serving veterans, we're talking about supporting veterans in all facets of their lives. We're talking about serving veterans' spouses and their children. The MVAA is committed to supporting our veteran families every step of the way," Hollier said. "Our former service members served and sacrificed for their country and deserve these benefits. It's not a handout and it's not a hand-up. It's simply getting the benefits and resources they earned for their service."

The MVAA is housed within the Michigan Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA).

"At the Michigan Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, we are guided by one fundamental promise: that those who are serving or have honorably served our state and nation are members for life," said U.S. Army Maj. Gen. Paul D. Rogers, adjutant general and director of the DMVA. "The MVAA has demonstrated that commitment over the last 10 years in their service to and advocacy for veterans. With more transitioning service members relocating to Michigan, it is vital that the MVAA continues to connect these veterans and their families to the state and federal benefits they need to thrive."

John Griffith is chair of the Michigan Commanders Group, which represents Veteran Service Organizations, and also the commander of the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Department of Michigan.

"Over the years, we have seen many service organizations unite under the cause of veteran advocacy," Griffith said. "The partnership between the VFW, Commanders Group and MVAA has become instrumental in reaching and impacting the lives of veterans and their families across Michigan. The MVAA's 10-year anniversary is an opportunity to reflect on how many lives have been changed due to dedication and shared mission of connecting veterans with their earned benefits and community service. Serving those who served us is an honor, and I am proud to have such a strong partnership within Michigan to lead as an example across the nation."

Andrea Norton, an Air Force veteran who works for the Saginaw VA Medical Center's Suicide Prevention Team, has collaborated with the MVAA for years. Norton was one of the women veterans featured in the MVAA's She is A Veteran outreach campaign, which has resonated with thousands of former service members across Michigan.

"I am probably MVAA's biggest cheerleader, so much so that people sometimes think I work for them," Norton said. "But we all need to cheer each other on and break down agency silos. I have developed impactful relationships with numerous colleagues at MVAA, and through these relationships and having a dedicated community engagement role, we have all been able to work collaboratively to strengthen the work we all do to support veterans. No one agency can nor should do it alone; we all have a role to play. Each VA hospital has its own multi-county catchment area, but MVAA covers the entire state. With a statewide reach and the 1-800-MICH-VET resource hotline, it makes sense that MVAA would be a connector for anyone working in the veteran advocacy space."

# MEET THE GUARD EVENT

Local communities, colleges, and high school students met members of the Michigan Army National Guard (MIARNG) over the past month at several "Meet the Guard" events hosted across the state of Michigan. # LATVIA HONORS MING

A new national postage stamp was unveiled on May 3, 2023, by Latvia Post, honoring the 30th anniversary of Latvia's defense cooperation with the Michigan National Guard under the National Guard Bureau's State Partnership Program (SPP).

The stamp, which features the image of a UH-60 Black Hawk helicopter, was unveiled during a series of events held in Latvia's capital to reflect upon the accomplishments and relationships generated from three decades of shared experience.

Currently, the UH-60 Black Hawk is a major line of effort for the SPP, which will soon see Michigan and Latvia flying the aircraft together to improve mutual air mobility capability. "There is a lot of talk these days about how a country cannot safely exist without a strong military defense capability," said Mārcis Vilcāns, chairman of the board for Latvia Post. "The 30-year cooperation between the Latvian National Armed Forces and the Michigan National Guard certainly meets these criteria, so we have issued this new stamp to remember old achievements and to look ahead toward future objectives."

Around 200 dignitaries from Latvia, as well as a delegation of Michigan National Guard leaders, gathered inside Riga's ornate "House of the Blackheads" for the event, which also included a reception and film screening on the 30-year bond. The film documented many notable achievements of the SPP, including the development of the Latvian National Guard, medical and engineer cooperation, the establishment of Latvia's Joint Terminal Attack Controller (JTAC) program, multiple combined deployments to Afghanistan, and the certification of Lielvārde Airfield as a fully functioning base for NATO air power.

Michigan and Latvia were one of the first pairings under the SPP, which has now grown to more than 85 similar partnerships between a U.S. state's National Guard and the national armed forces of a partner country.

U.S. Army Maj. Gen. Paul Rogers, adjutant general of the Michigan National Guard, reflected on the partnership's roots, which can be traced back to Michigan's vibrant Latvian-American community.

"30 years ago, it was the adjutant general's secretary, a Latvian-American woman named Dace Mason, who walked into the general's office when the list of Baltic counties seeking security cooperation opportunities came out," said Rogers. "She pointed to Latvia and said, 'General, here is your partnership." In a combined awards ceremony, five members of the Michigan National Guard were decorated in person by Latvian Chief of Defense, Lt. Gen. Leonīds Kalniņš, for contributions to cooperative exercises and exchanges. Award recipients included Col. Robert Frazer, Lt. Col. Adam Jenzen, Lt. Col. Bartley Ward, Maj. Catalin Bugan, and Command Sgt. Maj. (ret.) Jon Sawyer. Other recipients who were unable to attend in person include Col. Ravindra Wagh, Lt. Col. Mark Gorzynski, Lt. Col. (ret.) Dustin Budd, and Maj. (ret.) Adam Betz.

"Looking back 30 years, I would like to congratulate the great talents who started this cooperation, who saw the value that true friendship can bring to building military capability," said Kalniņš, "I believe there is a bright future to our cooperation; I trust the capability of our people, in both countries, who day by day, hour by hour, will keep and renew the military capabilities that are necessary to defend our society, our people, and our democratic values."

Rogers also presented each of Latvia's former chiefs of defense with a special commemorative coin recognizing three decades of mutually beneficial achievement.

Leaders on both sides of the partnership acknowledged that Russia's aggression in Ukraine has underscored the value of close coordination and cooperation between Allies to assure every inch of NATO soil is defended.

"Time can cause some partnerships to weaken, but that is not the case with Latvia and Michigan," said Rogers. "Time is what makes our relationships stronger, what makes our bond more inseparable, and what gives us the assurance that we can rely on one another in times of difficulty."

*"We will always be there for one another, and we will always support one another,"* he added.

The stamp unveiling and award ceremony followed an event earlier in the day dedicating a special photo exhibit celebrating the 30-year Michigan-Latvia cooperation at Bastejkalna Park in the heart of Riga.

More events are taking place throughout early May, including joint performances between the Michigan National Guard's 126th Army Band and the Latvian National Guard Orchestra to celebrate the partnership's groundbreaking achievements.





# NORTHERN Strike 23-1

The muzzle flash of an M240 machine gun chatters brightly against a snowcovered embankment. Below, military vehicles pulling field artillery guns grind to a halt as Soldiers duck and begin to return fire. A pickup truck blocks their way. From behind it, a man in tiger-striped camouflage fires a weapon that looks like a rocket-propelled grenade launcher.

"CONTACT," someone yells.

Today, Northern Michigan is a twenty-degree snow globe. And this is an ambush.



The scene is part of Northern Strike 23-1, an Army National Guard-sponsored exercise held Jan. 20-29 at the National All-Domain Warfighting Center in Northern Michigan. The Humvees are driven by Soldiers from the Wisconsin National Guard's 1-120th Field Artillery Regiment, while the M240 and RPG launcher (using blanks) is fired by members of the Michigan National Guard's Northern Strike planning team, who serve as opposing forces (OPFOR) in this battlefield scenario inject. launcher (using blanks) is fired by members of the Michigan National Guard's Northern Strike planning team, who serve as opposing forces (OPFOR) in this battlefield scenario inject. *"The point of OPFOR is to give you a realistic training event so that the unit can build readiness,"* said Sgt. 1st Class Todd Teuling, opposing forces manager for the Northern Strike planning team. *"The big thing is the element of surprise because they don't know it's coming."* 

Teuling explains that throughout the 18-month planning cycle for the exercise, Northern Strike staff work with the units from around the Department of Defense who plan to participate, gathering input on the type of training they need to accomplish. This is often determined by upcoming deployment or mission requirements.

Teuling's audience for Northern Strike 23-1 is approximately 600 personnel from across the active and reserve components of the U.S. Army, Air Force, and Marine Corps. They have all traveled to Northern Michigan because of the geography, resources, and accessibility of the National All-Domain Warfighting Center, which includes Camp Grayling and Alpena Combat Readiness Training Center. The exercise is designed to build readiness in near arctic conditions while training to meet the objectives of the Department of Defense's Arctic strategy.

During execution, Teuling and other members of the Northern Strike planning team don tigerstriped fatigues and join civilian contractors to carry out the scenario injects, adding unpredictability to the training experience with many simulated weapons and tactics that force participating units to react and make real-time decisions under pressure. "We try to cater to what the units want, and then we take that request and mold it into a scenario based on what we have to work with here on the ground," said Tueling. "We can put different elements into it, whether it's [small] unmanned aerial vehicles, simulated chemical attacks, machine gun fire, indirect fire, small probes, and heavy attacks."





All of this added to the already challenging conditions of Northern Michigan in January, makes the Northern Strike winter exercise a trial of resilience for those training here. "You don't get to pick the enemy, the location, or the weather when it's time to fight, so you have to train in all conditions," said U.S. Army Maj. Rustin Billings, 120th FA brigade fire support officer, Wisconsin National Guard. "A lot of the soldiers build that character piece when it's a natural thing you have to overcome; it's not artificial."





# COLLEGE TUITION LEGISLATION


Governor Gretchen Whitmer joined National Guard members, their families, and state lawmakers to sign legislation that expands the Michigan National Guard state tuition assistance program eligibility for spouses and dependents. Tuition assistance helps with recruiting, retention, and the overall quality of life for the Guard members and their families.

This bipartisan bill will lower the cost of higher education for spouses and children of Michigan National Guard Members," said Governor Whitmer. "I am proud that we can work across the aisle to support our service members and their families, who put their lives on the lines to keep us safe and stand tall for our values and freedoms. As Michiganders, we will have their backs."

"Since the program's inception, over 6,000 guard members have benefited from MINGSTAP and now thousands of eligible spouses and dependents will have the same opportunity to earn a tuition-free degree or professional certificate," said U.S. Army Maj. Gen. Paul D. Rogers, adjutant general and director of the Michigan Department of Military and Veterans Affairs. "Michigan is serious about supporting military families who have made significant sacrifices on behalf of our state and nation."

House Bill 4199 expands eligibility for tuition assistance to spouses and dependents of National Guard members and increases the funding cap from \$10 million to \$15 million. The Michigan National Guard Tuition Assistance Program provides financial assistance for service members attending any public or private college, university, vocational school, technical school or trade school located in Michigan.

"With the signing of HB 4199 into law, National Guard families in Michigan will have the flexibility to use the educational benefits that they have earned," said state Representative Jennifer Conlin. "The law will fulfill a dual purpose: directly providing opportunities to service member spouses and dependents and tackling the challenge of recruitment and retention head-on through the offering of this incentive."

The following items MUST be included in a Retired Pay Application: (Please note: This is only applicable to Michigan National Guard retirees! If you served elsewhere, please contact 1-800-MICH-VET)

1. Retired Pay Application - DD Form 2656 and DD Form 108 - Must use the current form or it will be rejected by HRC & DFAS.

- 2. Separation Orders transferring service member to the Retired Reserve.
- 3. Notice of Eligibility (NOE) 20-year letter or 15-year letter if issued.
- 4. Retirement Point Statement NGB Form 23B.

5. Reserve Component Survivor Benefit Plan election – DD Form 1883, 2656–5, or 2656–6. This must be submitted within 90 days of receipt of NOE. If not, a default selection will be made for you based on dependent information on record at the time.

6. Banking information for Direct Deposit - you will need the name of the institution, their mailing address, routing number, and account number.

7. Beneficiary information – you will need to provide the name, address, and date of birth for anyone you wish to include as a beneficiary for Final Pay or as part of a Survivor Benefit Plan.

## Ready to apply for your retirement?

The following items MUST be included in a Retired Pay Application:

(Please note: This is only applicable to Michigan National Guard retirees! If you served elsewhere, please contact 1-800-MICH-VET)

1. Retired Pay Application - DD Form 2656 and DD Form 108 - Must use the current form or it will be rejected by HRC & DFAS.

2. Separation Orders transferring service member to the Retired Reserve.

3. Notice of Eligibility (NOE) - 20-year letter or 15-year letter if issued.

4. Retirement Point Statement - NGB Form 23B.

5. Reserve Component Survivor Benefit Plan election – DD Form 1883, 2656–5, or 2656–6. This must be submitted within 90 days of receipt of NOE. If not, a default selection will be made for you based on dependent information on record at the time.

6. Banking information for Direct Deposit - you will need the name of the institution, their mailing address, routing number, and account number.

7. Beneficiary information – you will need to provide the name, address, and date of birth for anyone you wish to include as a beneficiary for Final Pay or as part of a Survivor Benefit Plan.
